Highlights:

- All stumps removed from areas 89 and 100
- Most stumps flagged in areas 48 and 47
- First two scraped areas on TNC land cleared of saplings
- 3rd ("lowest") area on TNC land opened up

We met at 8:30 am at NCP pavilion 5 and enjoyed breakfast and networking with TNC and Deloitte. As the Deloitte group headed out with Molly, David and Nate to clear saplings at the scraped TNC areas at Goat Hill (the first 2 scraped areas were cleared of saplings and the 3rd (lower) area was cleared of saplings with cut stumps treated with 50 ml. of herbicide), four of the FSLSB members accessed areas 89 and 100 through Becky's farm around 10 am. Chris and Anna cleared around previously flagged stumps in these areas while Henry and Mike used their chainsaws to cut the stumps flush with the ground. All stumps in areas 89 and 100 are now removed.

Once all the stumps in areas 89 and 100 were prepped for cutting, Anna and Chris proceeded to flag stumps in areas 48 and 47. Everybody returned for lunch at NCP at 12:45 pm
